THE SACRAMENT OF THE LORD'S SUPPER

THE INVITATION Pastor Conklin-Wood

Pastor: As we gather at the table of our Lord, we affirm again our faith in Him and our desire to be fed by His hand. When we break the bread, is it not a sharing in the body of Christ? When we give thanks over the cup, is it not a sharing in the blood of Christ?

THE GREAT THANKSGIVING

Pastor: The Lord be with you.

People: And also with you.

Pastor: Lift up your hearts.

People: We lift them to the Lord.

Pastor: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

People: It is right to give our thanks and praise.

Pastor: It is indeed right and our duty to give you thanks and praise, Almighty God, for You alone are holy:

**Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might,

Gluten-free bread is provided at every service. For those sitting in the balcony, we would invite you to come to the nave of the sanctuary as we begin the distribution of elements to receive communion.
